Westbrook trustee for the benefit of Caroline & William and children which she may have by Anthony R. Williams her husband of the other parts Witnesseth that the said Joseph W. Cloud for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and seventy one dollars lawfully money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said John D. Westbrook trustee aforesaid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said John D. Westbrook trustee aforesaid reserving to the said Anthony R. Williams his life right in a certain tract or parcel of land containing by a late survey one hundred and eight and a half acres be the same more or less lying and being in the county aforesaid on the south side of the river Roanoke and bounded as follows by the land of William & Sons Kendrick Williams brother and bounded as follows by the land of William & Sons Kendrick Williams and the said Joseph W. Cloud do have and he hold the said one hundred and eight and a half acres of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto right and shall come of lands with all and singular the appurtenances thereto appertaining or in any wise appertaining unto the said Joseph W. Cloud his heirs or assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said John D. Westbrook trustee for the benefit of the said Caroline & Williams and children aforesaid reserving to the said Anthony R. Williams his life right in said land to have and take to him for ever and said Joseph W. Cloud date for himself his heirs assigns
