Rawlings in the sum of thirty dollars and three cents and for the purpose of  
securing the said Patrick H. Rawlings from all damage that may or can  
arise it is agreed by the said Lambert Watkins that command in hand shall  
be made to the said William A. Bell for the benefit of the said Patrick H.  
Rawlings for the purpose aforesaid Now this Instrument therefore witnesseth  
that the said Lambert Watkins for and in consideration of premises aforesaid  
as well as for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand  
Received paid by the said William A. Bell the principal whereof is hereby  
acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth  
grant bargain and sell back over and confirm unto the said William A.  
Bell and his assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing by  
estimation one & 1/2 acres situate in the same town where the said Watkins  
purchased of the said Patrick H. Rawlings as will be fully apparent by  
reference to the deed recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County

Upon this express condition that if the said Lambert Watkins his heirs and  
or assigns shall fail to pay and satisfy the said land before default it  
is made that then and in that case the said William A. Bell or his legal  
heirs or representatives shall at the request of the said Patrick H. Rawlings  
or his assigns sell the said land for cash after giving one month's notice  
at the place containing full time adjourn and with the proceeds pay
