D. Penning the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold
and by these presents doth grant bargained sold unto the said Penning his heirs &
a certain tract or parcel of land with all appurtenances lying and being in the
County of Southampton and containing three hundred and twelve acres land or by
adjoining the lands of Horace W. Willey, James H. Bushnell and others & being in
some parts or parcels of land which were annexed to the said Nicholas M. Schell by

to Record the 23rd September 1844 to have and to hold the said tract of land on
premises with all appurtenances unto the said Penning his heirs and assigns forever. Now
