S<sup>r</sup> Benjamin Bristol Sr doth acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied  
and paid back granted bargain'd and sold alien'd in full and conformable and by  
these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the S<sup>r</sup> Wilborn Hodges to  
him and to his heirs forever all my right title and interest in and to each of two  
parcels as Berneils which I purchased of Nancy Hodges late being and being  
in the County and State aforesaid together with all houses out houses outhouses where  
ever belonging or in any way appurtenant to the said tract or parcel of Land &c  
have and to hold the same unto the said Wilborn Hodges to him and to his  
heirs forever and the S<sup>r</sup> Benj<sup>n</sup> Bristol Sr for himself his heirs Executors admin-  
istrators and assigns doth by these presents warrant and forever defend all right title
