Jenkins at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents the which whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Anthony M. Howell and Emma his wife both grantor and donee and by their present debt grant bargain and sell unto the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land wherein David Howell died seized and possessed lying and being in the County of Southampton and state aforesaid it being the distribution share of Anthony M. Howell by being one legatee of the said David Howell it being all of the said Anthony M. Howell's right in the said tract of Land and bound by the Land John B. Jenkins having been & also containing one hundred fifty five acres more or less in the whole tract together with all and singular the inclosure therewith remained and unenclosed and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns and all and every person or persons whatever he the said Anthony M. Howell and Emma his wife shall well and do by their present force warrant and defend the right and title unto the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns the Wilmfield whereof the said Anthony M. Brown and from Capt. Brown and wife to Asahel Sawyer and from Asahel Sawyer to Israel Bankford as trustee
