Jenkins at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to the said Anthony M. Howell and Emma his wife have granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land whereon David Howell died seized and possessed lying and being in the County of Southampton and State aforesaid it being the distribution share of Anthony M. Howell the being our legatee of the said David Howell it being all of the said Anthony M. Howell's right in the said tract of Land and bound by the Lands John B. Jenkins hereby cove- nants containing one hundred forty five acres more or less in the whole tract together with all and singular the reversion reversions remainders and remainders and other parts and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the Tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns and all and every person or persons whatsoever by the said Anthony M. Howell and Emma his wife shall well and do by these presents forever warrant and defend the right and title unto the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns Our Witness whereof the said Anthony M. Howell and Emma his wife have hereunto set their hands and faces their seals the day and date as first above written
