This Indenture made and entered into this 17th day of July one thousand eight hundred and forty seven between Robert Revell of the first part Ben & Pope of the second part and Harrison & Pope of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas the said Robert Revell is justly indebted to the said Harrison & Pope by bonds bearing date as follows one bond executed to C & Magrath for one hundred and five dollars bearing interest from the 14th day of Novr 1846 and other bonds executed to said H & P Pope for twelve dollars 84/100 dated 8th June 1847 one demand 1st day Oct 1847 one other bond for ten dollars dated 11 July 1847 and Execution for seventeen dollars five cents due 1st day of Jan'y 1847 the cost said out in the Name of Jacob Barnes and other Execution for seventeen dollars 83/100 due 5th Decr 1846 said out by H & P Pope and account due Robert M. Huels supposed to be fifteen or twenty Dollars and the said Robert Revell being willing and desirous to secure the aforesaid debt by cash now in his hands to wit the said Ben & Pope trust it and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Robert Revell that he has granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell to the said Ben & Pope his heirs and assigns forever his present crop of all kind viz crop of corn fruit peas potatoes cotton &c also the surplus if any in a certain tract given by the said Robert Revell to John M. Huels trust to secure the payment of several bonds executed to Jonathan Davidson for the purchase of Land TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to him the said Ben & Pope proper use and behoof forever Upon Trust nevertheless that the said
