Jenkins and Margaret A. his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Simon Muford his heirs & assigns a certain tract lot or parcel of land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton embracing what is called and known as Franklin lying on the west side of Slack water river and on both sides of the Post or Lancaster Rail Road adjoining the lands of Joseph Lanchford Bright Lamp Hardy Croft the heirs of Elias Corp. Jr. and others the tract of Land is comprised of three separate parcels of land and said to the said John B. Jenkins as follows. ONE Deed from Ruth D.
