

This Indenture made this 20th day of March in the year 1847 between Edwin N. Williams and Martha Ann his wife of the first part and Nathan Johnson of the other part and all of the County of Southampton witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars Virginia currency to them in hand paid or received to be paid by the said Nathan Johnson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Edwin N. Williams and Martha Ann have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell to him the said Nathan Johnson one certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing one hundred acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit west by the Lands allotted to the said Margaret Hart East by the French swamp and south by the Lands of Allen Stephenson and French Branch. To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the boundaries hereinabove and all and singular the premises throughout belonging unto him the said Nathan Johnson and his heirs forever being the tract of land allotted to Ammon B. Hart from the estate of his Father Ruffin Hart and being sold under a deed of trust the aforesaid Edwin N. Williams became the purchaser and they the said Edwin N. Williams and Martha Ann his wife do likewise sell and hereby relinquish to the said Nathan Johnson the right title and interest in the Dower Land now held by Margaret Hart and which at her death will come into possession of Edwin N. Williams and Martha Ann his wife but for this Indenture which equally binds the right to the tract above containing of One hundred acres as the said right which they hold in Mrs. Hart's tract. As witness they the said Edwin N. Williams and Martha Ann his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and date above named.
