This Indenture made this 12th day of August 1847. between Samuel P. Nicholson of the first part, Pritchard R. Edwards of the second part and John M. Loring of the third part, Witnesseth that whereas the said John M. Loring has become the surety of the said Samuel P. Nicholson to a bond due to Harrison P. Pope for one hundred and forty six dollars and 34/100 and the said Samuel P. Nicholson being and desiring to indemnify the said Loring against all loss which he might sustain on account of the aforesaid suretyship. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to the said Samuel P. Nicholson in hand paid by the said Pritchard R. Edwards the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Samuel P. Nicholson has granted bargained and sold and by these presents does grant bargain and sell unto the said Pritchard R. Edwards his heirs and assigns the following property to wit 5 loads of cattle and increase one carriage and harness and also two chains against the estate of Charles Rochelle amounting to fifteen seven and nine hundred dollars to have and to hold the property above conveyed unto him the said Pritchard R. Edwards his heirs and assigns upon the following trust and condition that whenever the said John M. Loring shall be obliged to suffer by occasion of the aforesaid debt or of any and all debts which the said Loring is surety for the said Nicholson then it shall be the duty of the said Pritchard R. Edwards upon being therein requested by the said John M. Loring or his Executors to make sale of the property above conveyed at public auction for cash and to collect the debt above named and out of the proceeds of the sale of the property and collection of the above named debt first pay and satisfy all costs attending this trust then pay and satisfy the above named debt as well as all other debts which the said Loring may be bound as surety for the said Samuel P. Nicholson and the surplus if any pay to the said Samuel P. Nicholson his heirs assigns or assigns In Testimony whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
