Articles of Agreement made and entered into this 25th day of September 1847
between John Gates of the one part and William D. Clark of the other part
of Wheeling: that the said Clark being desirous of carrying on the business of
business in the Town of Charleroi and being unable in consequence of other employment
to attend to the duties thereof the said Gates has this day commanded and agreed
to conduct the said business as the agent of and for the benefit of the said Clark.
And the said Gates has received of the said Clark the sum of five hundred
dollars to be invested in stock of goods to carry on the aforesaid business
the entire property in the said stock and control over the same to be and remain
solely in the said Clark under whose direction and superintendence the said Gates
is to manage the business aforesaid and the proceeds of said stock are to be invested
as occasion may require in additional stock to supply the place of such as may
have been sold. The said Gates is to have no interest in or control over the said
stock or its addition to said stock except as the agent of the said Clark in whom
Name alone the business is to be conducted and the said Gates at his part command
and agrees faithfully to adhere to the said business and to account where required
for all money received or expended in the prosecution of said business and the
said Clark at his part commands and agrees to pay the said Gates reasonable
compensation for his care and labor about the business aforesaid. In witness whereof
the said parties have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals to day and
year aforesaid Wheeling to wit the 25th day of September 1847
