This Indenture made and entered into on this day of in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two by and between Nathaniel M. Osborn of the County of Cumberland acting under a deed of the County Court of Southampton made at their March Term 1841 in the case of Bignins Merchant & Co. Bignins and others as Commissions to sell and convey the undivided interest in a tract of Land called the poplar swamp tract lying in the County of Southampton supposed to contain six thousand two hundred and forty six acres either in whole or in such parts as may be sold to the greatest advantage of the following infants to wit: William Allen Elizabeth Carter and Mary M. Bignins infant children and heirs of Bignins Bignins decd. Martha A. Bignins of the County of Surrey Widow of the said Bignins Bignins decd. Carter Esq. of the County of Prince George and A. A. Brydson Esq. of D. D. Brydson and of the Town of Christburg of the first part and Davis Bignins of the County of Southampton of the second part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand four hundred and eighty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Davis Bignins the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Nathaniel M. Osborn acting as Commissioner for the said infants said hereby sell grant and convey all the right title and interest of the said infants and the said Martha A. Bignins Carter Esq. and A. A. Brydson Esq. in and to the said sell grant and convey all their respective rights title and interest in the said Davis Bignins in a tract or parcel of Land situated in the County of Southampton and containing by actual survey made March 2nd 1842 by Thomas B. Dwell four hundred and forty two and one half acres to the said land or as it may hereafter be called a portion of the said tract of Land called Poplar swamp or Albion Quarter and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a new corner in Lewis Wadswells line near the New Road or Mill path thence the course of said Road or path N. 83° E. 105 poles to the center of the County Road thence along the center of said Road S 33° E 407 poles to a new corner in the Carr line near the head of the Road thence along the Carr line S 60° W 111½ poles to a white Oak thence S 60° W 44 poles to a black gum thence S 84° W 16 poles to a sweet gum thence S 65° W 23½ poles to a corner thence S 45° E 42½ poles to a Red Oak thence S 37° E 6 poles to a pine thence S 28½° E 35½ poles to a post Oak thence S 24° E 37 poles to the corner of the poplar branch thence down the run of said branch to the margin of the
