

Cypress Swamp or Rockledge Mill pond at high water mark thence up the margin of said Swamp or Mill pond including three small islands in the River of said Cypress Swamp at high water mark thence up the River of said Swamp to the Ashbur Swamp thence up the River of said Ashbur Swamp to a corner for said Lewis Bregant thence along his line to the beginning. I shew and to hold the said parcel or tract of Land to him the said Lewis Bregant his heirs and assigns forever until the said Nathaniel M. Osburn as Commissioner aforesaid and not otherwise and the said Nathaniel M. Osburn Carter Elliot and A. A. Bregant each do hereby consent and agree with the said Lewis Bregant that they have good right and title to convey the said tract or parcel of Land and they will by their persons forever warrant and defend his title to the said tract or parcel of Land and that of his heirs and assigns against the claims of themselves and all persons claiming under them and all other persons whatsoever the said Nathaniel M. Osburn specially under the power conferred upon him by the said voters of the County of Southampton and the other parties for themselves and their heirs respectively. Chamberlain being sworn deponent and saith that he is well acquainted with the hand writing of the said Williamson and verily believes that the name of the said William is on the said deed subscribed is in the proper hand writing of the said John H. Williamson whereupon it is ordered that the said deed be recorded.

This Indenture made and entered into on this day of \_\_\_\_\_ in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two by and between Nathaniel M. Osburn of the County of Cumberland acting under a power of the County Court of Southampton made at their Court term 1841 in the case of Bregant vs. Osburn et al. and others as Commissioners to sell and convey the undivided interest in a tract of Land called the poplar Swamp tract lying in the County of Southampton and supposed to contain six thousand two hundred and forty six acres more or less in such parts as may be sold to the greatest advantage of the following infants to wit: William Albert Elizabeth Carter and Mary M. Bregant infants children and heirs of Jeffrey Bregant decd. - Harriet A. Bregant of the County of Surrey Widow of the said Jeffrey Bregant decd. - Carter Elliot of the County of Prince George and A. A. Bregant decd. of the County of Prince George of the first part and Lewis Bregant of the County of Southampton of the second part; Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ to them in hand paid by the said Lewis Bregant,
