

The Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged: And the said Nathaniel M. Osborn  
 acting as Commissioner for the said infant doth hereby set forth and convey all rights  
 title and interest of the said infant and the said Nathaniel M. Brigant  
 Edler and A. A. N. Bragant Esq. of Duxbury doth do hereby set forth and  
 convey all their respective rights titles and interests to the said Davis Bryant in  
 a tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Southampton and containing  
 actual Survey made March 3<sup>rd</sup> 1842 by Thomas N. Dorell three hundred and  
 twenty five acres (in the same word as before) it being a portion of the said tract of  
 Land called Poplar Swamp or Allen's quarter and bounded as follows to wit Beginning  
 at a Post Oak standing on the Road. At corner of the first tract of Land in said  
 Davis Bryant's land thence his land along the Head South 60 degrees nearly 20 poles  
 thence 5 1/2 & 3 1/2 poles to a Post Oak thence 5 1/2 & 6 1/2 poles to a large Red  
 Oak stand 5 1/2 & 7 poles to a pine stand 5 1/2 & 7 poles to the margin of the  
 Brook outlet or Allen's Mill pond thence down the margin of the said brook or  
 Mill pond at high Water mark the various courses turning to the peoples swamp  
 thence up the margin of said swamp to the deep branch thence up the margin  
 of said branch to the mouth of the pond and up the margin of said mouth  
 pond to the head of said branch at high Water mark thence up the head of  
 said branch the various courses thereof along the line of the aforesaid Head  
 of Land to a Water Oak stand 3 1/2 & 2 1/2 poles to a pine stand 3 1/2 & 1 1/2  
 poles to a white Oak stand 5 1/2 & 2 1/2 poles to a black oak stand 5 1/2 & 2 1/2  
 poles to the beginning. It having and holding the said parcel or tract of Land to  
 him the said Davis Bryant his heirs and assigns forever and the said Nathaniel  
 M. Osborn as Commissioner aforesaid and not otherwise and the said Nathaniel  
 M. Osborn and Carter Edler and A. A. N. Bragant Esq. do hereby warrant and defend  
 to the said Davis Bryant that they have got good right and title to convey the said  
 tract or parcel of Land and they will by their present power warrant and defend  
 title to the said tract or parcel of Land and that of his heirs and assigns against the  
 claims of themselves and all other persons claiming under them and all other persons  
 whatsoever: the said Nathaniel M. Osborn specially under the power contained  
 in his by the said Board of the County Court of Southampton and the other parties  
 for themselves and their heirs respectively: Will witness whereof the parties have here
