Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars current money of the Commonwealth of Virginia to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said William D'Horst Samuel H. Holmes and Phogus Saint Peter bargain and sell and by their parents do bargain and sell unto the said William Wellons his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances situate lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing One hundred acre more or less and bounded as follows to wit: bounded by the Lands of William Wellons south by the said of said Wellons East by Mrs. Somers Land and west by Gilbert Drury's Land together with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging the several and several remainders and remainders yearly and other rents issue and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances hereunto before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto him the said William Wellons his heirs and assigns forever and the said William D'Horst acting as special Trustee Samuel H. Holmes and Phogus Saint Peter for themselves and their heirs the said tract of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William Wellons his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of the said William D'Horst as Trustee and Samuel H. Holmes and Phogus Saint Peter and each of their heirs and of all their parties whatsoever shall will and do warrant and forever defend by their parents the said Drury whereof they the said William D'Horst Samuel H.
