This Deed of Bargain and Sale No<sup>t</sup> M<sup>o</sup> in same to Edward Barbosa was acknowledged  
by said Jones and admitted to Record

This INDEMNITY Deed and entered into the 13<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year  
of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty seven between George Williams and Martha  
his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one party and  
Benjamin & Dyer of the same County and State of the other party witnesseth that  
the said George Williams and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum  
of twenty Dollars and twelve cents Current money of the Commonwealth to them in  
hand paid by the said Benjamin & Dyer at and before the sealing and delivery  
of these presents the Recipient whereof in consideration have granted Bargained  
and sold and by these presents do and make of their said grant Bargain and sell  
unto him the said Benjamin & Dyer his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or  
parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and  
parish of Saint Lucia containing by a late survey twenty four and a half acres (by the  
said Surveyor a half acre) and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a Spanish Oak  
stump adjoining the land of said Benjamin & Dyer in Cuthbert D<sup>r</sup> Barbosa his slaves  
adjoining said Barbosa line N 8 W 11 poles to a red oak tree N 2 E 13 poles to a  
red oak tree North 17 poles to a red oak tree N 10 E 10 poles to a pine tree N  
16 W 14 poles to a pine tree corner for said Cuthbert D<sup>r</sup> Barbosa then along a low  
bank of marshy trees between the parties to their private N 8 1 E 17 1/4 poles to a pine  
tree N 13 E 24 poles to a red oak tree N 0 1/2 E 23 poles to a sweet Gum  
standing at the fork of a small branch about the run of said branch to a Stock  
Bank in said Benjamin & Dyer line then along his line S 47 W 16 5 poles to the  
beginning: also having agreed to sell the above described tract or parcel of Land unto  
him with all and singular its appurtenances there belonging or in any wise appertaining  
unto him the said Benjamin & Dyer his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only pur-  
pose and behalf of him the said Benjamin & Dyer his heirs and assigns forever unto  
the said George Williams and Martha his wife for themselves their heirs and  
admits do and make of their said grant Bargain and agree to and with the said Benjamin  
& Dyer his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns that they will by their grants warrant and  
forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and  
promises and agrees to and with the said George Williams and  
other persons or persons whatsoever: Give witness whereof the said George Williams and  
Martha his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year  
first above written
