This Indenture made and entered into on this 29th day of Octr year 1847 by and between Abraham Drach Annuity Drach his wife and William C Myrick trustees as per Bond recited to him by the said William Drach for purpose therein named which Trust Bond is of Record in the Clerk's Office for the County of Southampton of the one part and Jacob Darns of the other part all of said parties of the County aforesaid: This Indenture Witnesseth that the said William Drach Annuity his wife and William C Myrick trustees as aforesaid each and all three of them of the one part as aforesaid have for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred eighty seven dollars and forty cents the same being paid by the said Jacob Darns under and by the direction of the said William Drach to Benjamin Harrison Pope in discharge of said Drach due to them as will appear by referring to the deed of Trust about named to which Trust Bond the above named Mrs C Myrick is trustee in consideration of which this Indenture is signed sealed and delivered and by which Indenture they the said William Drach Annuity his wife and the said William C Myrick at the said Drach request and the assent of all others concerned having been granted bargained and sold and by their presents do and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said Jacob Darns his heirs and assigns forever a certain parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & parish of Saint Luke containing by a late Survey eighty three half acres of Land by the same Survey a half Acre more or less as to the precise bearing it being a part of the tract of Land conveyed in Trust to the said William C Myrick as aforesaid said parcel of Land bounded as follows to wit beginning at a black gum & live oak corner standing in or about the head of a branch stream along & near Trust land of Marked trees 5 6 46 W 46 poles to the first road so called the road of said Road forming a corner in Darns Drach his share along said Road & a black corner 188 poles to a corner as well for Benoit Benoit Darns his share and William Biquant his share along said Biquant his share of Marked trees N 2 1/2 E 8 6 poles to a black gum & live oak corner for said William Drach & B Darns in the said Biquant his share thence up the said branch the boundaries of the one of the said to the beginning to have and to hold the above described parcel of Land and
