Davis the receipt whereof the said Americus Vick doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit the said John H. Davis his heirs and assigns his Exrs + admors by this presents that the said Americus Vick hath granted bargained and sold and by this presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John H. Davis to his heirs and assigns one certain tract of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and known as the tract of Land formerly belonging to Edwin Vick containing three hundred and fifty acres more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) West by the Lands of James Vick called Vichoreville South and South east by the Lands of Nicholas C. Williams East by the Lands of James Vick North by the Lands of Robert C. Cluff and William Davis North West by the Lands of Hudson Drake and the Land belonging to the Vichoreville tract with the way waters profits Commodities heres amants appurtenances & appertaining to the said Land belonging or in any way appertaining and the residue remains and remainders rents and profits thereof of every kind whatsoever the right title interest or claim of him the said Americus Vick or his heirs or assigns forever SO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said plantation parcel or tract of Land and premises with the appurtenances to the same said John H. Davis and his heirs the right and title of Land the said Americus Vick doth agree to warrant and defend against all persons or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof IN WITNESS the said Americus Vick hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written" 1847 the here yard is reserved for burying ground
