Lurley and Paul's Kello are lawfully bound with the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of one thousand dollars to the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally jointly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 20th day of December 1847

The Condition of the above obligation is such that Whereas the Court of Southampton County hath appointed the above named John M. Lurley Commissioner of the Revenue for Saint Lukes parish in the said County for the Term of one year Now if the said John M. Lurley shall faithfully perform the duties of the said Office during his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void or else remain in full force and effect Signed sealed & acknowledged

Worrell and his heirs forever One certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid and adjoining the Land of John Edwards the said Worrell and others containing by estimation One hundred and fifty acres or the same more or less the boundaries and quantity of acres will here fully appear when surveyed: And if the said William M. Everett doth not come such right and title as is vested in him as trustee aforesaid In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and subscribed my name this 20th day of November 1847
