This Indenture made and entered into this 16th day of July 1841 between William P. Currier Sheriff of the County of Southampton of the one part and Jacob Barnes of the same County of the other part. Whereas Holliday Revere being in custody of the Sheriff of the said County upon an execution issued out against him from the Clerk's Office of Southampton County in favor of Benjamin Griffie did on the 20th day of October 1843 take the Oath of insolvency before J. D. Summerville Justice of the peace for the said County and delivered in a schedule of his estate which schedule contains the following real estate to wit: all my interest in a piece of Land given by the Will of Holliday Revere to my father John Revere during his life with remainder to the said John Revere's children being at the time of his death and previous to his discharge from custody the said Holliday
