

Claims of any other creditors legally entitled to priority over the mortgage aforesaid
 to the President & Directors of the Board of public works aforesaid, and by the said section
 of the said act it was provided that the sale of the said Road should be made by the
 Board of public Works in all respects (not sooner before provided for) as provided in
 the General Law passed the 18th day of March 1841, and the Board should bid for
 the road such price as they should think it ~~was~~ ^{value} thereof: And Whereas the
 Stockholders of the Portsmouth and Roanoke Rail Road Company having duly given
 their agent in a sale according to the terms of said act: the President and Directors of the
 Board of public Works in conformity to the provisions of the said act of February 27th 1846
 did by their agent sell by public auction on the 25th day of September 1846 before the
 Commissioners of Norfolk County, in the Town of Portsmouth on the River, ^{limitation} and
 provisions set forth in said act all the estate property and effects of every Nature and
 kind whatsoever and wheresoever situated and being embraced by the Mortgage aforesaid
 by the Portsmouth and Roanoke Rail Road Company to the President and Directors of the
 Board of public Works particularly specified in the said act: at which sale the
 President and Directors of the Board of public Works by their agents aforesaid became the
 purchasers of all the said estate property and effects embraced by the Mortgage aforesaid
 and by such purchase ipso facto became & being public and corporal by the Name
 and Style of "the Seaboard and Roanoke Rail Road Company" and entitled to hold and
 enjoy and occupy the Road and all the other property and effects of every Nature and
 kind of that Portsmouth and Roanoke Rail Road Company with all the franchises, rights
 privileges and immunities granted to and conferred upon it any time thereafter by the State &
 and the State of North Carolina in so ample & manner as that Legislature could transfer
 them subject in all respects and in every thing to all the due regulations and penalties
 required prescribed and enjoined by any Law or Laws then in force respecting the Portsmouth
 and Roanoke Rail Road Company and subject to the provisions of the act of the General
 Assembly entitled "an act prescribing certain general regulations for the incorporation of
 Rail Road Companies" passed March 15th 1837: And Whereas the President and Directors
 of the Board of public Works by the Name and Style of "the Seaboard and Roanoke Rail
 Road Company" did by an Ordinance dated the 8th of September 1846 duly recorded
 in the Clerk's Office of Norfolk County Court upon certain terms conditions and stipulations in
 said Ordinance mentioned have senior grant and to farm let unto the Trustees of Portsmouth
 and their successors all the estate property and effects of every Nature and kind whatsoever
 and wheresoever situated or being as purchased and acquired by them under the sale aforesaid
 together with all the rights privileges and immunities so acquired by and made in the said
 Seaboard and Roanoke Rail Road Company subject to the due regulations and penalties
 provided by Law from the said eighth day of September 1846 for and during and unto the full
 end and term of seven Calendar Months from thence first running and fully to be completed
 and ended of the said term first of the General Assembly of Virginia should not then
 be less than and be at an end all which will more fully and at large appear by reference
 to the said law: And Whereas by virtue of an act of the General Assembly entitled
 "an act to authorize a loan of the Seaboard and Roanoke Rail Road Company to the
 Trustees of Portsmouth and the city Council of Norfolk jointly and authorize a subsequent
 sale of the Road to the same parties" passed March 15th 1847 the Board of public
 Works in their capacity of President and Directors of the Seaboard and Roanoke Rail Road
 Company did by Ordinance dated the 21st day of May 1847 recorded in the Clerk's
 Office of Norfolk County upon certain terms conditions and stipulations aforesaid mentioned
 have senior grant and to farm let unto the said Trustees of Portsmouth and their successors
