

This Indenture made and entered into this 15th day of December in the year of our Lord eight hundred and forty seven between William O'Bailey of the one part and Alexander Faison of the other part and heirs of the State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Wm O'Bailey in consideration of the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Alex Faison at or before the sealing and delivery of this present the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold unto by the present do grant bargain and sell unto the said Alex Faison his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton containing one hundred and eight by the same more or less and bounded as follows: On the west by Lands belonging to the set of Major Boncourt on the north by Justice Branche on the east by Peter Brink on the south by Drury Rivers together with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging. To have and to hold the said piece or parcel of Land with all tenements hereditaments and all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or intimated to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every other right tenement and appurtenance unto the said Alex Faison his heirs and assigns forever and the said Wm O'Bailey for himself doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Alex Faison free from the claim or claims of him or his heirs or assigns and all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and with warrant and defend by them present.
