Edwards are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars for the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally, firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated the 11th day of January 1848

And Condition of the above obligation is such that Whereas the above named Septimus Dandor is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 1st day of December 1847 to take effect from the expiration of the term of the present Sheriff and to continue in Office until the first quarterly Court to be holden for the said County in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty nine. If therefore the said Septimus Dandor shall and truly collect and receive all Offences for and due put into his hands for collection and duly account for and pay the same to the Officer to whom such fees are due respectively at such times as are prescribed and limited by Law: and shall well and truly execute and due return make of all process and precepts to him directed and pay and satisfy all sums of money and other things received by virtue of any such process to the person or persons to whom he owes his or their Executors administrators or assigns and in all things shall truly and faithfully execute and perform the said Office of Sheriff during the term of his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void or otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
