This INDEMNITY made and entered into this six day of January in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty eight between Mary Barnes,
 his wife & her brother Edward Cooke of the County of Northumberland
 State of North Carolina of the first part and Henry Cooke of the County of Northumberland
 State aforesaid of the second part witnesseth that the said Mary Barnes his
 brother Edward Cooke and his wife Lydia B. a. of the County of Northumberland
 March 20, examined Barnes and his wife Lydia B. for and on consideration of the sum of Sixty six
 pounds and twenty four dollars lawful money of Virginia to whom the said Mary
 Barnes Cooke and Barnes and his wife Lydia B. in full paid by the said Henry
 Cooke at or before the execution of this present the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 good faith granted bargained sold and by these presents doth grant Barnes and
 Cooke unto the said Henry Cooke his heirs executors administrators and assigns
 forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing Nine hundred and eighty four
 acres more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
 and known by the name of the Blunt place marked and bounded as follows
