 and desirous to recover the aforesaid debt and interest. Now this INDENTURE  
 Recorded that for and in consideration of the premises and for the further  
 payment of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said 16<sup>th</sup>  
 in the hands of the said Charles Knight and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof  
 is hereby acknowledged by the said James Story and Elizabeth his wife hath given  
 geanting her assent and doth and by that present doth give grant bargaine and  
 sell to the said Charles Knight and his assigns forever our certain tract or parcel  
 of Land containing Seventy six acres by the same more or less and bounded by the  
 lands of Mathewus Clarke & Knight and the heirs of Lewis Dornell and the  
 heirs of Jasiah Dornell did know as the Land formerly owned by Norfleet 13  
 Custer in the said County and State aforesaid. To have and to hold the said  
 16<sup>th</sup> day of Novr present and for ever upon trust nevertheless that the said  
 16<sup>th</sup> day shall at the request of either one of the parties aforesaid after giving at  
 least ten days notice of the time and place of the sale sell at public auction  
 the said Land and out of the proceeds first pay the expenses thereof then the aforesaid  
 debt and interest due the said Charles Knight and the balance if any pay over to  
 the said James Story or his legal Representative and the said James Story and Elizabeth  
 his wife covenant with the said 16<sup>th</sup> day that he is possessed of a full simple right to  
 the aforesaid Land and that he will forever warrant and defend the same against
