

constructing this Rail Road and the Rail road & thereon conveyed in this said Mortgage of May 4. 1838. and purchased by the Board of public works under the said mode by them as the 1st of September 1846 also the following personal property to wit: one stationary Engine called the *Eligant* two six wheelers four pair of bellows one large turning lathe one other turning lathe one small pattern lathe thirty pair of Smiths hammers four sets of stocks and one other bridge four hand hammers three each saws one wheel prop one pair of flat iron scales one engine and the tender called *Romulus* one engine called *Amos* and her tender Engine No 4 and tender three right wheel bar cars three right wheel flat cars Coach *Weldon* Coach *Virginia* Coach *Portsmouth* Two coach from two set bar cars six repairing cars one mail cart two brack barbor chains one large stove two smaller stoves one wooden clock Office fixtures one iron ^{new} one flat iron scale also all other property of every nature and kind whatever and wherever situated or being which was conveyed to the said trustees of Portsmouth by the President and Directors of the Board of public works in their capacity of President and Directors of the Seaboard and Roanoke Rail Road Company by their deed of mortgage with the reference to which has already been made together with all the rights franchises and immunities appertaining to the same and the Seaboard and Roanoke Rail Road Company "To have and to hold the same to the President and Directors of the Board of public works and their assigns to their use and behoof provided always and upon condition that if the trustees of Portsmouth shall well and truly pay their said loans when respectively at maturity and all the interest which they occur thereon so that no default shall happen in the payment of either of them then and in that case their personal shall cease absolutely and become void any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding" *Wm Wm Wm* of the trustees of Portsmouth have approved hereto their corporate seal and in testimony thereof James Munroaught their President has signed his name on the day made and given above written
