

This Indenture made the fourth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty seven between Jordan Johnson and Pitha his wife of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the one part: and John B. Jenkins of the County and State aforesaid of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Jordan Johnson and Pitha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said John B. Jenkins at and before the executing and delivery of this present Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they the said Jordan Johnson and Pitha his wife have granted, conveyed and sold and by their presents do and will of their full good lawful and well with the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns all his her and their undivided interest, share right title claim and demand in and to the lands of which Archibald Johnson died seized and possessed by the said Jordan Johnson during life to the said undivided interest as an estate of inheritance from his father the said the said Archibald Johnson died. Containing One hundred and twenty two acres by the same more or less and adjoining the lands of William Jones A M Howell James B Maples and others and lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton the premises and premises premises and premises equally and other rents issue and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract piece parcel or tract of land or the aforesaid undivided interest thereof unto the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns forever And the said Jordan Johnson and Pitha his wife for themselves and their heirs the said undivided interest right title and distributive share in and to the said tract or parcel of land or lands of which Archibald Johnson died seized and possessed as aforesaid with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Jordan Johnson & Pitha his wife or either of them their heirs or assigns of their heirs and of all and every other persons persons whatsoever they shall well and to the warrant and forever defend by their presents In witness whereof the said Jordan Johnson & Pitha his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year as first above written
