To have and to hold the said tract given parcel or tract of land in the aforesaid undivided interest aboveunto the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns forever to and for the uses, profits and benefit of him the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Jordan Johnson and Eliza his wife of themselves and their heirs the said undivided interest right title and distribution thereon and to the said tract or parcel of Land or Lands of which Archibald Johnson died seized and possessed as aforesaid with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John B. Jenkins his heirs and assigns free from the claims or claims of those the said Jordan Johnson & Eliza his wife either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever they shall well and truly warrant and forever defend by these presents IN WITNESS WHEREOF the said Jordan Johnson & Eliza his wife have caused set their hands and sealed the day and year as first above written.
