whom reside in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia Witnesseth
that the said Elizabeth Barrett have for and in consideration of the sum of two
dollars to her in hand paid by the said William Vick at the receiving and
delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have bargain
and sold by these presents doth hereby convey unto him the said William Vick
his heirs and assigns all the right and interest and estate which she the said Elizabeth
Barrett now has in and to a certain lot or parcel of land lying in the said County
of Southampton and in the parish of Saint Luke bounded by the Lands of Henry
