these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and
by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Martha Barrett and her heirs
and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid
containing eighty one acres more or less being the tract of land which the said
Mary Barrett purchased of Jacob Barrett which the said Jacob Barrett purchased
of E. D. Will together with all and singularly the appurtenances to the said tract
or parcel of land belonging or in any way appertaining To have and to hold
the said tract or parcel of Land and premises unto her the said Martha Barrett her
heirs and assigns for the only proper use and behoof of her the said Martha Barrett
her heirs and assigns forever With the said Mary Barrett for herself her heirs
Executors and administrators hereby Covenant and agree to wish the said Martha Barrett
her heirs and assigns that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the aforesaid
tract of Land to her the said Martha Barrett her heirs and assigns against the
Claim or demand of her the said Mary Barrett and of all and any person or
