 M Council, his heirs Executors administrators or assigns the sum of four thousand
 dollars with legal interest thereon as by instrument being had to said deed
 Recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County will more fully and at large
 appear. And Whereas the said sum of four thousand dollars with the interest
 thereon as aforesaid has been fully paid and satisfied by the said Joseph D
 Council. And he the said Joseph D Council hath requested the said Joseph D
 Council, to convey and release the property so conveyed in trust, as above written.
 Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of one dollar
 to him the said Joseph D Council, in hand paid by the said Joseph D Council,
 at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said
 Joseph D Council, does hereby acknowledge to the said Joseph D Council, the said
 James M Council, of the third party consenting thereto hath bargained sold aliened
 released and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain sell alien release and
 confirm unto the said Joseph D Council, his heirs and assigns the two tracts of
 land above mentioned lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid
 together with the slaves male and female and their increase & likewise the personal
 property of every kind being the same property that was conveyed by the said
 Joseph D Council, to the said Joseph D Council, in trust for the benefit of
 James M Council as is above mentioned with their and every of their appurtenances
 as free and absolutely discharged of and from the said trust and every
 part and parcel thereof with all the estate right title and interest of him
 the said Joseph D Council, trustee as aforesaid for James M Council, in or
 to the same. To have and to hold the said property mentioned to be truly
 released as aforesaid with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said
 Joseph D Council, his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said
 Joseph D Council, his heirs and assigns forever: Nor shall he the said Joseph
 D Council, nor his heirs Executors administrators or assigns at any time hereafter
 have any claim demand or interest in or out of the premises, or any part or
 parcel thereof. And all the right title and interest which the said Joseph D
 Council acting as trustee for the said James M Council, might or could have
 had in the said premises and every part and parcel of the same: and
 by these presents are entirely excluded and forever barred. In Witness
