This Indenture made the 4th day of February in the year eight hundred
and forty eight between Joseph & Council of the one party and Robert Raiford of
the other party and all of the County of Southampton Witnesses that the said
Joseph & Council for and in consideration of six hundred dollars lawful money of
the Commonwealth to him in hand paid or secured to be paid at or before the
making and delivery of these presents by the said Robert Raiford the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents have
bargained and sell unto the said Robert Raiford his heirs and assigns forever a
certain tract or parcel of land with all and singular the appurtenances situate
lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing two hundred
and about more more or less And bounded as follows to wit^h North by Elizabeth
Dugher East and South by Robert Heath and West by the Tropic Swamp
To have the hold the said tract or parcel of land with the tenements housements
and all and singular other the premises and appurtenances mentioned or intended
to be bargained and sold And every part and parcel thereof unto him the said
Robert Raiford his heirs and assigns forever And the said Joseph & Council for
himself and his heirs the said tract of land with all and singular the premises
and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Robert Raiford his heirs and
assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said Joseph & Council or his
heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall will and
doe warrant and forever defend by these presents And Witness whereof the said

to Joseph & Council of the County aforesaid in the sum of six hundred dollars
good and lawful money of the United States by his bond bearing date the 4th day of
February in the year 1848 payable the first day of November next And Whereas
Robert Raiford is desirous to secure more effectually the payment of the said sum of
six hundred dollars Now therefore the deed made the 4th day of February
1848 between Robert Raiford and Mary and his wife of the first part William
D Wood of the second part and Joseph & Council of the third part Witnesses
that the said Robert Raiford and Mary and his wife for and in consideration
of the sum of one dollar to them in hand paid by the said Joseph & Council
before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged have granted bargained sold aliened repossessed released and confirmed
by these presents to grant bargain sell alien repossess release and confirm
unto the said William D Wood his heirs and assigns two certain tracts or parcels
of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton
And bounded as follows to wit^h the one containing two hundred and
about more more or less on the North by Elizabeth Dugher East and West
