paid by the said John Driffin have bargained and sold and by their private do and
each of them have bargained and sell unto the said John Driffin his heirs and assigns
a certain tract of Land containing by estimation one hundred and eighty two p. more
or less being the tract purchased by the said William Edwards from Mary Driffin
and bounded by the lands of John Driffin George Moore and Elizabeth Driffin together
with the roads and divisions partly and also with the said Mary Driffin and her heirs
and parcel thereof: to have and to hold said tract of Land with the tenements
buildings and all and singular the premises herebefore mentioned or intended to be
bargained and sold unto the said Mary Driffin and her heirs and assigns forever: And the said William Edwards and Sally his wife for
themselves and their heirs the said tract of Land with all and singular the premises
and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John Driffin his heirs and assigns
forever from the claim or claims of them the said William Edwards and Sally his or
either of them then or either of their heirs: with of all and every power what so ever shall
well and do warrant and defend by their persons or by their heirs and assigns the said
