 year of our Lord eight hundred and forty eight between Benjamin S. Barrett
 of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and
 Henry H. Hill of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth
 that the said Benjamin S. Barrett for and in consideration of the sum of
 fifty eight \$58.00 Dollars Current Money of the Commonwealth to him in hand
 paid by the said Henry H. Hill at or before the sealing and delivery of
 these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said Henry
 H. Hill his heirs and assigns forever an certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and
 being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke containing
 by estimation nearly one fourth of an acre to the said tract there is a top and lowest as follows
 to wit Beginning at a small point or tree corner tract between said Benjamin
 S. Barrett and Henry H. Hill in the main Wells line thence along a line
 between the parties 587 & 44 poles to a corner low fort from the ditch on the
 South west side thence parallel with the ditch 534 & 1 poles thence 341 3/4 & 3
 poles to a post Oak standing at the head of a small branch thence a double
 nearly corner along his line to said main Wells line thence along his line to the
 beginning To have and to hold the above described tract a parcel of land and
 premises with all and singular its appurtenances thence belonging unto him the said
 Henry H. Hill his heirs and assigns forever And the said Benjamin S. Barrett for
 himself his heirs executors and assigns doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said
 Henry H. Hill his heirs executors assigns and assigns that he will by these presents warrant
 and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid tract a parcel of land and
 premises against the claims and demands of all and every other person or persons whatever
