for themselves their heirs executors and administrators doth hereby covenant and
agree to and with the said N. B. Bryan his heirs executors and administrators and
assigns that they will by their private warranty and forever defend the right
and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and the premises and
every part and parcel thereof against the claims demands of all and every

This Indenture made this 27th day of December in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and forty seven between John D. Tiller and Christiana of his
wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Edmund C. Bailey of the
County of the Supra of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John D. Tiller
and Christiana his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars
lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Edmund C. Bailey his
heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being
