 of the sum of fifty dollars to Mary Barrett in hand paid and receipt the said
 Davis Vick of all claims against him the said Davis Vick as purchaser of a certain
 tract or parcel of land bought by the said Davis of Mary Barrett and also the
 Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain and sold and do
 by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said William Vick his heirs
 and assigns forever one certain piece lot and parcel of land lying and being in
 the County aforesaid and bounded as follows by the lands of William Bryan
 Thomas Newsum and Henry Kinderl containing by estimation nearly six acres be
 it the same more or less To have and to hold all the said granted land
 and premises above mentioned unto the said William Vick his heirs and assigns forever
 and the said Davis Vick for himself his heirs and assigns forever agrees to and with
 the said William Vick his heirs & that he will forever warrant and defend all
 the right title & interest of the said premises before mentioned unto him the said
 William Vick his heirs & assigns forever against the claims & demands of him the
