the said Harrison D Pope may think proper by giving at least ten days previous
notice of the time and place of such sale at least three public places in the aforesaid
County and the proceeds of such sale after paying all costs attending the execution
of this trust be applied by the said Harrison D Pope to the discharge of the above
debts owing to the said Henry Hundred and the surplus money pass to the said
