This AGREEMENT made and entered into this 20<sup>th</sup> day of March 1848 between Henry Rindell of the one party and Rebecca Felt of the other party both of this County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas the said Rebecca Felt has a survey entered on a certain tract of Land situated in a suit of Chancery for the County by Thomas L. Allen in right of his wife Elizabeth of Henry County and admitted to the said Allen by Commissioners the said Allen Elizabeth his wife conveying their title to Rindell estate in the Town of Danville in the State of Virginia and which deed is admitted to Record in the Roanoke Court for the Corporation of Danville and the said Danville State Court authorizing the said Henry Rindell to make sale of the said tract of land upon such terms as he may think proper the said Rebecca Felt wishes and agrees with the said Henry Rindell to take one six parts of the tract of Land aforesaid in four square on the North side of said tract of Land which will fully show by referring to the Commissioners Report the boundaries which is as Recoll. in the Clerk Office in the County of Southampton which the said Henry Rindell do assign to the said Rebecca Felt @ but twenty four acres it to the said New or old and the said Rebecca Felt doth hereby release all claims entered in said tract of land which she was entitled to by receiving the said twenty four acres that same more or less.

Whereas the said Henry Rindell for and in Consideration of the sum of ONE hundred & Ninety dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and doth by these presents grant, bargain and sell unto the said James Dorell son of Sager his heirs and assigns forever and certain piece lot and parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and joining the Land of Daniel Sager. James Dorell and others and being a part of the Land recovered of Henry Sager by Thomas L. Allen in right of his wife Elizabeth in right
