Roachell Esq' of James Roachell doth hereby covenant to and with the said Daniel Mufer that she will manumit & deliver the title to the above named slaves against the claims & demands of all persons whatsoever In witness whereof I the said Martha B. Roachell Esq' of James Roachell doth have signed set my hand and affixed my seal this 20th day of March 1848
