This Indenture made the 22^d day of January in thirteenth eight hundred and fifty eight between James Gardner and Betty his wife of the County of Hanover and State of Virginia of the one part and James W Gardner of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the second part in consideration of fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said James W Gardner at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold with by their parents the receipt whereof is hereby made James W Gardner his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia well bounded by the Courts of the said James W Gardner Wright Reuter Conrad Gardner and Gardment Esqrs and containing but more more or less together with all the tenements and appurtenances and reversions remainments and remainders present and also with all the profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises hereinafter mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights tenements and appurtenances to the said James W Gardner his heirs and assigns forever until the said James Gardner and Betty his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular other the premises and appurtenances before mentioned with the said James W Gardner his heirs and assigns for ever from the claim or claim of them the said James Gardner and Betty his wife or either of them their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall will and to the warrant and forever depend by their parents the said James W Gardner and Betty his wife have bought set their hands and seals the day and date above written
