More at & before the sealing and delivery of this present the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell unto the said H. D. More his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation one third of an acre be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a small Hickory @ corner here shown @ street line running North about fifty or seventy five yards bounded by the lands of P. P. Williams on the west by the land of H. D. More on the west by the public road on the south and the North side the above described tract or parcel of Land unto him the said H. D. More his heirs and assigns forever the said P. P. Risher each by the land of George B. Cary North by the land of George Raulings East and West by the land of George A. B. Barchants estate To have and to hold possess and enjoy the said tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Samuel J. Rollings his heirs and his heirs forever and the said William B. Brantley and his wife for themselves and their heirs the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises and the said Samuel J.
