This Indenture made and entered into the 4th day of Octo 1845 between William
 S. Pihrell James H. Pihrell and Virginia E. his wife and Daniel H. Dringor and Nancy
 M. E. his wife of the one part and Nicholas M. Pihrell of the other part Witnesseth that
 the said William S. Pihrell James H. Pihrell and Virginia E. his wife and Daniel H.
 Dringor and Nancy M. E. his wife in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars to them in
 hand paid by the said Nicholas M. Pihrell (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged)
 have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the
 said Nicholas M. Pihrell his heirs and assigns all their interest right and title which they
 the said William S. Pihrell James H. Pihrell and wife and Daniel H. Dringor and wife
 or either of them have or hold in and to a certain lot or piece of Land situate near
 the Town of Samsalem in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit beginning
 at a post on the east about two hundred and twenty eight yards from the lot called
 Price now owned and occupied by James H. Pihrell thence back at straight line about
 North and East hundred and four yards to a post thence at straight line about North west
 to Nicholas line on the post heading from the main road to the lot near first stone by the
 said post and the main road to the beginning it being the lot or piece of land on
 which the said Nicholas M. Pihrell now resides and which was conveyed by Thomas C.
 Jones & wife to Nancy Quarmby by deed bearing date the 20th day of July 1835 and admitted
 to Record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County & to have and to hold the interest
 aforesaid conveyed & intended to be conveyed unto him the said Nicholas M. Pihrell
 his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Nicholas M.
 Pihrell his heirs and assigns forever In Witness Whereof the said William S.
 Pihrell James H. Pihrell and Virginia his wife Daniel H. Dringor and Nancy M.
 E. his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the 10th day and year
 first above written
