

This Indenture made the 18th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty seven between William T Turner of the County of Southampton the one part and Howell Harris of said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said William T Turner for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Howell Harris the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that the said William T Turner of the County aforesaid have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Howell Harris he his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing three hundred sixty seven and three fourth acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County aforesaid on the south side of three creeks and adjoining the lands of Peter Alfred & Sons Propy Iron Thomas P Tuxen Eliza Tuxen and the Land of the said Howell Harris

That the said Howell Harris to hold the said bargained tract or parcel of Land above mentioned with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said William T Turner to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Howell Harris he his heirs and assigns forever And if the said William T Turner the aforesaid have and premises unto him the said Howell Harris he his heirs and assigns well warrant and forever defend the said tract or parcel of Land against the right title claim or interest of all and every other person or persons whatsoever The Witnesseth that the said William T Turner hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and date first above written

This Indenture made with witness unto on this 15th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty eight between Thomas A Day and Catharine his wife of the Town of Portsmouth in the State of Virginia of the one part and Thomas Drake of the County of Southampton in the State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas A Day and Catharine his wife for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars Current Money of the Commonwealth of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Drake at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Drake he his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton a parcel of land containing by survey two hundred and three acres be the same more or less bounded by the Towns of Edinboro Rich Necke Elizabeths Necke and Dringbells and others To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said Thomas Drake he his heirs and assigns forever and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Thomas Drake he his heirs and assigns forever And the said Thomas A Day and Catharine his wife for themselves
