This Indenture made and subscribed on the 3^d day of March in the year of our
last one thousand eight hundred and forty eight between Benjamin B. Briffet of the one part
and Pally Drwelle of the other part both of the County of Southampton and State
of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Benjamin B. Briffet who was appointed special
Commissioner to sell the lands of Carg Drwelle did for and in consideration of the
sum of three hundred and thirty two dollars and fifty cents to him in hand
paid (or to be paid) by the said Pally Drwelle at or before the making and
delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both bargain
and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Pally Drwelle
his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in
the County aforesaid adjoining the lands of John Cump except land and
John Harris do^t containing by estimation 135 acres more or less and known as the
Land of which Carg Drwelle died seignor To have and to hold the above named
parcel of Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
wise appertaining to the said Pally Drwelle his heirs forever And the said Benjamin B. Briffet
for himself his heirs and assigns with the said Pally Drwelle his heirs and assigns doth
hereby forever warrant and defend the right and title to the above named parcel of
Land so far as is vested in him as Commissioner free from the claims of all and every
person or persons whatsoever And testimony whereof he the said B. Briffet caused
these presents to be his hand and seal the day and date above written
