Witnesseth that the said James Vick for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and four dollars to him in hand paid by the said John Vick the receipt whereof the said James Vick and wife Delilah both hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said John Vick his heirs executors and assigns by their presents then the said James Vick and Delilah his wife both granted bargained and sold by their presents both grant bargain and sell unto the said John Vick and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract of Land lying in the County aforesaid called Vicksville containing three hundred and sixty one acre and bounded as follows (to wit) South by John B. Vicks land with the corner of the house of James Vick east by John B. Vicks land north by the land of Mary H. Vicks and west by Samuel Kella's land and Nathl. Rich's with the house except within certain profitable Concession heretofore appertaining to the said plantation or tract or parcel of land belonging or in anywise appertaining and the messuages and other premises and other lands and people thereof of every part and parcel thereof and all the right title interest or claim whatsoever of him the said James Vick and wife Delilah or their heirs to him the said John Vick his heirs and assigns forever To have and to hold the said plantation parcel or tract of land and premises with the appurtenances to the said John Vick and heirs the right and title of said land the said James Vick and wife Delilah both agree to warrant and defend against all present or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof.
