 and between James Buffum Executor of Henry Hunsom of the one part and James
 Drake of the other part each party of the County of Southampton in the State
 of Virginia: Witnesseth that the said James Buffum in pursuance of the last Will
 and Testament of the said Henry Hunsom here at auction the day sold to James
 Drake divided and James Drake became purchaser thereof for the sum of
 sixty dollars the same being in hand paid by the said James Drake to him the
 said James Buffum Executor as aforesaid the Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
 and in consideration whereof he the said James Buffum doth hereby convey all
 the right title interest and estate which he hath unto the Will aforesaid to the
 land of which the the said Henry Hunsom died seized and possessed supposed to
 be right acre of land the same bounded by the lands of the following names
 to wit Jacob Barnes Emmanuel Parker & said Drake To have and to hold
 the said land and every part and parcel thereof to him the said James Drake and
 to his heirs and assigns forever with all incidents and appurtenances to the said
 land belonging or in any way appertaining to him the said James Drake his

 with this Indenture for the sum of one hundred & twenty five dollars with the said
 Thomas Squire having devised to secure the said sum of money & debt to the said Thomas
 Drake of his assigns: Now Therefore this Indenture Witnesseth that for the
 consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar in hand
 paid to the said Thomas Squire by the said Pante Kells at and before the making
