and State of Virginia Whereas the said Henry Soper is indebted to the said Ben O
Pope by bond bearing date the 11th of January 1843 for four hundred and forty
seven dollars subject to a credit of four hundred and twenty eight dollars and four
cents paid the 5th day 1847 and the said Henry Soper being indebted to the said
Ben O Pope in the sum of twenty six dollars and 67¹⁰⁰ by bond bearing date the
19th day of June 1848 and the said Henry Soper being willing and desirous to pay
the aforesaid debt and interest Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in
consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of one dollar to have in law
paid by the said Kindred at and before the sealing and delivery of this present the
