and William Barden of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Samuel H. Holmes in execution of a certain deed of Trust executed on the sixteenth day
of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight from Robert Horner to
Samuel H. Holmes to secure the payment of a debt due John Leghach whole debt is
filed in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County this 10th day of November 1848
having given due Notice of the time and place of sale at up and sold at public auction
to the highest bidder for cash one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation
thirty eight and one half acres be the same more or less bounded by the lands of
William Barden William Clay and the heirs of John Schmitt being the tract of land
conveyed by the deed of Trust above referred to and at the said sale made the
said William Barden became the purchaser of the said tract of land by bidding there
for one hundred and sixty six dollars which was the highest bid made for the same
Now therefore this Indenture further Witnesseth that the said Samuel H. Holmes
for and in consideration of the said sum one hundred and sixty six dollars to
him or him paid by the said William Barden the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant
bargain and sell unto the said William Barden his heirs and assigns the tract
or parcel of land above mentioned and described with the buildings and improve
ments and appurtenances thereto belonging "He have and to hold the same unto
him the said William Barden his heirs and assigns forever And the said Samuel
H. Holmes hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said William Barden
that he will warrant and defend the said to the promise above conveyed unto
him the said Barden his heirs and assigns against the claim of himself the said
Holmes and all persons claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof by thought
