and 24 cents to us in hand paid by William Dimes of the said County the receipt
whereof we do hereby acknowledge do by these presents grant bargain sell and convey
unto the said William Dimes his heirs and assigns @ certain tract or parcel of land

for myself my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said William
Dimes his heirs and assigns that I and my said wife are lawfully seized in fee
of the before granted premises that they are free from all incumbrances that I and
my said wife have @ good and perfect right to sell and convey the same to the said
William Dimes his heirs and assigns as aforesaid and that I will and my heirs executors
and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said William Dimes his
heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons And

forty eight
