and State of Virginia of the one part and William Drury of the same County and
State of the other part witnesseth that the said John Drury in Consideration of the
sum of One hundred and twenty dollars Cash in hand paid to or before the execution and
delivery of this present Doct except whereof is hereby acknowledged and
sold and by the present to bargaine and sell unto the said William Drury his heirs and
assign @ certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and in the County aforesaid
containing by estimation forty four acres by the same line or less at boundaries by the
known and reputated boundary thereof known as the Burnt Branch together with all and
singular marralls and runnalls commonall and accustomed yearly and other rents upon and
profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said
land for ever of land with its tenements appurtenances and all and singular the premises
hereinbefore mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel
thereof with every of the rights franchises and appurtenances unto the said William Drury
his heirs and assign forever and the said John Drury for himself and his heirs the
said tract for acres of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances
before mentioned unto the said William Drury his heirs and assign for from the claim
claims of him the said John Drury his heirs and of all and every person or persons
whatever shall well and truly warrant and forever defend by the present Doct Drury
whereof the said John Drury has recd and set his hand and seal the day and year
